

CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TWEED

BY-LAW NO. 2005-60

Being a By-Law to amend By-Law No. 2003-09, being a By-Law to provide for the regulating of cats in the Municipality of Tweed.

WHEREAS Section 103 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001 sets out the provisions for municipal by-laws regulating the keeping of animals, including the being at large or trespassing of animals;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Tweed deems it expedient to amend the by-law for regulating the keeping of cats in the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Tweed enacts as follows:


1. That Part II of Municipality of Tweed By-Law No. 2003-09 be amended as follows:
 2. No person shall keep, or do anything which may cause to be kept, more than three (3) cats in any residence in the Municipality of Tweed.
2. That all provisions of By-Law No. 2003-09 not amended by this by-law shall remain in effect.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and take affect immediately upon the passing thereof by the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Tweed.
