NOTICE OF ELECTION
Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (s.40)

The Municipality of Tweed will be using a mail in ballot for the 2014 municipal election. An election will be held for the following positions:

Deputy Mayor.....**One (1) to be elected**
Councillors.....**Three (3) to be elected**
Hastings & Prince Edward District School Board-South East Hastings Ward.....**One (1) Trustee**
Conseil des Ecoles Publiques de L’Est de L’Ontario.....**One (1) Trustee**

The following positions have been acclaimed and will appear on your ballot with an X already placed in the voting box indicating that it is not necessary to vote for these positions:

Mayor – Jo-Anne Albert.....**Acclaimed**
French Separate School Trustee – Diane Burns.....**Acclaimed**

Voter kits will be mailed to all eligible electors during the week of September 29th, 2014. Voter kits will include a detailed set of instructions for completing, securing and returning the ballot and declaration form. **Please follow the voting kit instructions carefully to ensure your ballot is considered valid and can be counted.**

Eligible electors who do not receive a voter kit by October 8th, 2014 should contact the municipal office during regular office hours to obtain a replacement kit. Electors who receive more than one voter kit should complete and return one kit only. Electors who own or rent more than one property in a municipality are entitled to vote only once in that municipality. Voter kits must be completed and returned separately for each family member.

Return envelopes containing the elector’s signed declaration form and marked ballot (with ballot placed inside the secrecy envelope) may be sent by mail in the postage paid return envelope no later than October 18th, 2014. After that date completed kits must be brought to the drop-off centre at the Municipal Office at 255 Metcalf St., Tweed during regular office hours until 4:30 p.m. on Friday, October 24th, 2014. On Voting Day, Monday, October 27th, 2014 completed voter kits can be dropped off between 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at the Voting Station located at the Tweed Public Library, 230 Metcalf St., Tweed. **Completed voting kits must be received by the Municipality of Tweed by 8:00 p.m. on Voting Day, Monday, October 27th, 2014.**
