CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TWEED

BY-LAW NO. 2022-13

Being a By-law to Amend By-law No. 2020-58, Being a By-law to Regulate Traffic and Parking in the Municipality of Tweed and to Repeal By-laws No. 2003-08, 2007-44, 2008-31, 2009-34, 2011-19, 2011-33, 2012-08, 2012-22, 2015-18, 2015-27, 2016-13, 2016-30, 2018-63, and 2019-27.

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Tweed has deemed it necessary to pass a by-law to prohibit or regulate the parking, standing or stopping of vehicles, or any class thereof, on highways or any part of a highway;

AND WHEREAS Sections 63 and 101 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, as amended, provide authority for related actions if a municipality passes a by-law for prohibiting or regulating the placing, stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on highways;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Tweed enacts as follows:
